Below are some forms we use on an ongoing basis, as provided by the Archdiocese.

[Annual Offence Declaration](#) – Volunteers and Lay Employees in “High Trust” positions must submit this form annually to confirm whether any police interaction has occurred since their original police records check was filed. High Trust positions are those involving vulnerable or youth populations, access to Church assets, or access to confidential information; other positions do not require a police check or this ongoing declaration.
